AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 14 dated 9.8.2022, under Sections 7, 7(A), 8 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (as amended by Prevention of Corruption Act, 2018) registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau Range Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the State appearing on advance notice is not disputing that notice under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. was issued to the petitioner, however, he failed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to unavoidable circumstances, the petitioner was not able to appear before the police authorities on the said date. He is ready to respond to notice under Section 41-A Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions submits that as on date, notice under Section 41-A Cr.P.C. has been issued. In case, his custody is required, he would be given three days' notice.

no further directions are called for.
