Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the concerned Court in terms of the notification G.S.R. 570(E) dated 25.08.1993, issued under Section 22(a) of the Passports Act, 1967, whereby citizens of India against whom proceedings in respect of an offence alleged to have been committed by them are pending before a criminal Court in India and who produce orders from the Court concerned permitting them to depart from India, are exempted from operation of the provisions of Section 6(2)(f) of the aforesaid Act.

Mr. Ankur Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, states that he has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
