1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.291, dated 22.10.2018, Police Station Manesar, District Gurugram, under Sections 120-B, 380, 411, 342, 386, 109, 506 IPC, and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 28.10.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Bijender Kumar, Renu and also of complainant

Sudhir Sharma and Manju Sharma have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves. Statements of petitioners No.3 and 4 not recorded being minor.

4. The complainant Sudhir and Manju Sharma in their joint statement had stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.291, dated 22.10.2018, Police Station Manesar, District Gurugram, under Sections 120-B, 380, 411, 342, 386, 109, 506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
