The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents to call the parties to the agreement to appear before them and to get the sale deed registered in favour of the petitioner.

It is not in dispute that the vendor under the alleged agreement to sell is not coming forward to get the sale deed registered in favour of the petitioner. The aforesaid dispute is not within the domain of a writ jurisdiction and is a private civil dispute to be resolved by taking recourse to the ordinary remedy of approaching the Civil Court. The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to have recourse to the alternative remedies available to her in accordance with law.
