This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty to the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Gagandeep Kaur, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4. A copy of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3— Superintendent of Police, Nuh to consider and decide the representation dated 22.08.2022 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for his life and liberty.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present

petition is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.3 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
