The petitioner herein has preferred the instant writ petition seeking appointment to the post of Sub-Inspector (sports quota) in Punjab Police pursuant to having applied under advertisement dated 07.07.2016. The petitioner herein had sought selection on account of her participation in the Commonwealth Championship.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Same was the situation on the last two dates of hearing also.

Learned State counsel would submit that the instant writ petition has rendered infructuous in view of the fact that the petitioner herein has been selected to the post of Constable by order dated 15.01.2021. It is contended that the petitioner's name is reflected at serial No.24 in the letter issued by the Special Director General of Police, Armed Battalion, Punjab Jalandhar.

I have perused the pleadings in the writ petition, wherein a limited prayer is made for appointment to the post of Sub-Inspector.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been putting in an appearance on the last two occasions besides today and, therefore, this Court would presume that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter, considering the fact that appointment has been offered to her as Constable by virtue of letter dated 15.01.2021.

Copy of the said letter dated 15.01.2021, reflecting appointment offered to the petitioner, is taken on record.

Consequently, the instant writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
