Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, is aggrieved against the reply/ order dated 11.05.2022 (Annexure P-11) and reply/ order dated 21.07.2022 (Annexure P-13). *Qua* his grievance, also submitted a representation dated 15.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) but the same has not been adverted by respondents till date. Hence the petition.

2. On advance service, learned state counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending representation dated 15.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation, as suggested by learned State counsel.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 15.12.2021 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within 3 months from today.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
