The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and to take appropriate action/register FIR against the persons mentioned in complaint dated 24.01.2019 duly received in the office of respondent No.3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine and take action on the issues raised by the petitioner in his legal notice/representation dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-5).

Learned State counsel has no objection if the directions is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice/representation dated 13.05.2019 made by the petitioner through his counsel.

In view of facts and circumstances of the case but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to examine the legal notice/representation dated 13.05.2019 (Annexure P-2), submitted by the petitioner through his counsel and decide the same as expeditiously as possible. If some substance is found in the averments made in the legal notice/representation, respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) shall take further action in accordance with law.
