[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.03.2019, in CWP No.27028 of 2018 in case titled as 'Jarnail Singh and others versus Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.27028 of 2018, was allowed vide order dated 28.03.2019 and the respondents were directed to release the tubewell connections to the petitioners after completion of necessary formalities to be carried out within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the respondents have complied with order (Annexure P-1) dated 28.03.2019 and released the tubewell connections, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
