Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.267 dated 30.09.2021 under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at
Police Station Chhappar, District Yamuna Nagar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was
passed by this Court on 28.10.2021: -

*“...Learned senior counsel for the petitioner has argued that as
per the allegations in the FIR, despite having a secret information
regarding the movement of the petitioner, he was never
apprehended at the spot and only the motorcycle and capsules*

were recovered at the spot. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not the owner of the motorcycle and his father is the owner, who is a Chemist and even on an earlier occasion, the petitioner, on similar grounds, was arrested in a case registered under the NDPS Act in the year 2016, in which he stands acquitted...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ram Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.10.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
