It is submitted that order of restoration of a demolished water course has become final inter-parties. Yet, the same has not been restored. In a civil revision arising out of a civil suit filed by the private respondents, the High Court was informed that the water course had been restored, however, it was dismantled very next date. Repeated representations have been given thereafter also, but no action has been taken. Finally, the legal notice dated 15.06.2022 has been issued, but the same has also not evoked any response.

Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 4 only.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.
