1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.04.2022, in CWP-18390-2020.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 01.05.2022 has been decided vide order dated 27.09.2022 and payment as per entitlement determined therein released to the petitioner, therefore, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
