1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.04.2022, in CWP-7582-2022.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P-1 dated 08.04.2022, reveals that CWP-7582-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide the claim made in legal notice dated 11.09.2021 by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefits, to release the same to him within four weeks thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the claim made by the petitioner in legal notice dated 11.09.2021 having been decided by the respondent and payment as per entitlement determined therein released to the petitioner, he does not press the instant

dated 03.10.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law to the extent the same is adverse to the interest of the petitioner.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
