This appeal has been filed against the concurrent findings of both the Courts below holding that appellant/judgment debtor has illegally encroached upon the land of respondents/decreed holders. Accordingly, the execution application was allowed.

A perusal of the judgment of the lower appellate Court shows that the demarcation was carried out as per rules and orders of this Court. This stands duly established as per testimony of Kanungo, Pawan Kumar who has proved his report. There is no evidence on record to dispute the same. It was, therefore, rightly held that the judgment debtor/appellant illegally encroached upon the land in question.

There is no ground to interfere with the concurrent findings of both the Courts below.

Dismissed.
