Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for directing the respondents to grant the benefits of Contributory Pension Scheme dated 12.12.2006.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
