The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. by petitioner-Raj Kumar @ Raju seeking grant of regular bail in case FIR No.514 dated 29.09.2020, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 354. 506 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 at Police Station City Ballabhgarh, Faridabad, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 18.01.2021. Though, it has been contended that the allegations in the FIR are not substantiated from the CCTV footage and hence the allegations are false and frivolous. He further submits that till date the petitioner has never misused the concession of interim bail. Thus the same deserves to be confirmed.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the victim is a minor and there are specific allegations against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the investigation is complete, challan has been presented and now the case is fixed for recording the evidence of prosecution before the trial Court.

Heard.

It would be a futile exercise to comment anything on the merits of the case, at this stage, as the trial Court is seized of the matter. There is nothing on record showing that the petitioner has ever misused the concession of the interim bail so far.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, order passed as on 18.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute during the trial.
