The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 & 2 to cancel the registration certificate of vehicle No. CH-01-AU-3399 registered in the name of the applicant sold to respondent No.3 on 16.03.2021, who neither got transferred the same in his name nor renewed the insurance of the same; along with certain other prayers.

The counsel for the respondents have submitted that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed and accordingly the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Even the petitioner, who is appearing in person, has not disputed the aforesaid fact.
