The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0215 dated 31.10.2020 registered under Sections 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 of Arms, 1959 (Sections 307, 326 and 201 IPC added later on) at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from Gurmeet Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 08.09.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
