This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for addition of Section 326 IPC in the headnote and prayer clause of the petition and for grant of pre-arrest bail and interim relief already granted to the petitioner under this Section also.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed. Section 326 IPC be added in the headnote as well as in the prayer clause of the main petition. The Registry to carry out the necessary amendments accordingly.

The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.137 dated 03.08.2022 under Sections 307, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added today i.e. 07.12.2022 vide application

bearing CRM-40750-2022) registered at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A short reply dated 07.12.2022 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record. The learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 13.09.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 13.09.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
