The petitioner, a law student, has sought directions to the official respondents to update the affiliation certificate of respondent No.2-Panjab University and also update the official website as the petitioner is not being granted admission to any university abroad unless the same is done.

Learned counsel for the respondents submit that the affiliation certificate has been updated and that the website of the Bar Council of India too has been updated. Thus, the writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

In response, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner deserves to be compensated for the loss caused to him.

The writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file a civil suit for compensation.
