The instant petition had been instituted under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking invocation of the writ jurisdiction of this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondent No.2 to take action against the respondents No.3 and 4 in the light of the complaint dated 27.08.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that she is in receipt of a letter whereby respondent No.2 has called upon respondent No.3 and 4 for facing inquiry for 07.10.2022. She contends that since the respondents have already initiated the proceedings on the complaint so instituted by the petitioner, the primary grievance of the petitioner stands redressed. She, however, submits that the complaint was moved by the petitioner in the year 2020 and the same is now taken up for consideration by the authorities

concerned after a lapse of approximately two years, so the authorities concerned may be directed to complete the impending inquiry within a time bound manner and preferably within a period of six months.

On this, learned counsel for the respondent No.2 makes a statement that the inquiry into the complaint made by the petitioner shall be concluded within a period of six months from the date next fixed.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the counsel for the respondent No.2, the present petition stands disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

Needless to mention that the respondent No.2 shall remain bound by the statement made today in Court.
