Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.70, dated 11.11.2020, under Sections 188 and 500 of IPC and Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 (Section 505 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after filing of this petition, a compromise has been arrived at between the parties and he has filed CRM-M-16534-2021 for quashing the aforesaid FIR on the basis of the compromise. The said petition has been allowed by this Court vide order of even date. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the above, no further order is required to be passed in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
