AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 3 dated 17.5.2021 under Section 7, 13(1) (b) and (2) of Prevention of Corruption Act and 120-B IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Vigilance Chandigarh.

This Court vide order dated 9.9.2022 stayed the arrest of the petitioner subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Investigating Officer submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is co-operating.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the confirmation of the interim relief.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to continuing to join investigation as and when called for. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. The petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called for. He shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of accordingly.
