ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is working as an Additional District Manager with the respondent on a salary of ₹70,244/- has been fastened with a liability of ₹97,989.50/- on account of issuance of chargesheets vide order dated 03.02.2022/21.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) which has been upheld by the appellate authority vide order dated 03.08.2022 (Annexure P-3). The petitioner has preferred the statutory review petition along with an application of stay (Annexure P-4) thereagainst under Rule 21 of the Punjab Civil Services (Punishment and Appeal) Rules, 1990 read with Regulation 21 of the PSWC (Staff) Regulation, 2002, with respondent No.3 on 25.08.2022 which has not been decided till date. He submits that in a similar petition bearing CWP-26467-2019 titled as **Kulwinder Singh vs. Board of Directors, The Punjab State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Ltd. and others**, wherein the petitioner was also a Salesman with Markfed and recovery of ₹1,55,29,777/- had been directed against him, the Coordinate Bench in the revision petition pending adjudication had directed the revisional authority to decide the petition within a

period of three months. The Coordinate Bench had also directed that further recovery also be stayed subject to the final order that may be passed by the revisional authority.

Issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. Amanpreet Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Reviewing authority (respondent No.3) to consider and decide the Review Petition (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Further recovery from the petitioner shall remain stayed and would be subject to the final order that may be passed by the appellate authority.
