This is a petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 21.7.2014 (Annexure P-5), passed by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar; as well as, order dated 7.6.2013 (Annexure P-3), passed by the court of District Revenue Officer-cum-Collector, Jind, exercising the powers of Collector, Jind, whereby the petitioner was ordered to pay the deficiency in the stamp duty and registration fees to the tune of Rs.1,54,000/-in the registered sale deed No. 759 dated 14.5.2012 along with penalty of Rs.5000/-; and further notice (Annexure P-6) for payment of the said amount.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already paid the stamp duty imposed against the petitioner vide the impugned order. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous.
