The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.403 dated 09.10.2020 under Section 20, 25 and 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that on the application filed by the petitioner, the call recordings and tower location of the police officials and the petitioner were requisitioned by the learned trial Court and these are the part of the record before the learned trial Court. He has submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present bail application in order to file bail petition before the trial Court, so that his plea of false implication based upon tower location etc. can be taken up for consideration.

The learned State counsel has stated that he has no objection in case the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the learned trial Court/Special Court by filing bail application before the learned trial Court/Special Court.

In view of the aforesaid position, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition to approach the learned trial Court/Special Court for filing an appropriate application for grant of bail in accordance with law.
