RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

The petitioner, appearing in person, submits that in spite of the fact that the order dated 30.08.2018 has been passed by the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, Delhi (DRAT), directing the DRT-II, Chandigarh, to dispose of his S.A. No. 827/2017, in a time bound manner, the DRT-II, Chandigarh, has not decided the same. He submits that on account of long pendency of his case before the DRT-II, Chandigarh, he is suffering.

Having heard the petitioner in person, it is observed that after passing of the order dated 30.08.2018 by the DRAT, the petitioner is required to pursue his case before the DRT-II, Chandigarh, and it is only in case, his grievance is still not redressed and the matter is not proceeded with, the petitioner would be entitled to take up further proceedings.

When confronted with the aforesaid observation, the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the writ petition as well as CM-7379-CWP-2018 with liberty to approach the DRT-II, Chandigarh, for early disposal of his case.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. Needless to say that in case, the petitioner approaches the DRT-II, Chandigarh, his case, i.e. S.A. No. 827/2017, shall be considered and decided expeditiously.
