The child of the petitioner was allegedly beaten up by respondents No.3 & 4, on account of which an FIR was got registered against them. Subsequently, they were suspended. However, in appeal filed by them, the order of suspension has been stayed and thus, the writ petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of examining the validity of the stay order, the writ petition may be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the pending appeal expeditiously.
