The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate direction to the respondent-authorities to hold an independent investigation for the registration of criminal case bearing FIR No. 0110 dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Section 3/4/5 of the Explosive Substances Act, 1908 and Section 13 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State has pointed out that the investigation has already been concluded and final report stands filed in January, 2022.

In view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The petitioner shall be at liberty to
