The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the letter dated 02.09.2015 (Annexure P-8), whereby the petitioner has been burdened with liquidate damages, lower rates, illegal deductions and general damages etc.

Written statement on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 has already been filed wherein a plea has been taken by the respondents that as per paragraph 2900 of Indian Railway Standard Conditions of Contract, there is a specific remedy of settlement of disputes through arbitration which is binding on the respective parties.

Faced with the above said submission, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to have recourse to the alternative remedy available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being accepted.

Disposed of accordingly with liberty as aforesaid.
