HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

In the present petition, grievance of the petitioner is that certain promotional increments for which he became entitled for upon his retirement as Superintendent on 31.10.1997 have not been granted to him, due to which an anomaly has occurred with regard to the fixation of his pay and consequently the pensionary benefits.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply, wherein it has been mentioned that all the benefits for which the petitioner was entitled for keeping in view the last pay drawn by him have already been paid to him and no further payment is required to be made by the respondents.

Learned counsels for the respondents submit that in case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to fixation of his pay and consequent pensionary benefits, he can approach the appropriate authority

with the said grievance by filing appropriate representation and in case any such representation is filed by him, the same will be decided in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions made on behalf of learned counsels for the respondents, no grievance of the petitioner in the present petition survives at this stage, therefore, the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage with a liberty to raise the grievance, if any remains, before the authorities concerned by filing an appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
