The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.212 dated 29.09.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 326 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Rama Mandi, district Jalandhar.

On 29.10.2021, this Court had passed the following order : -

“The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia relies on issuance of notice and grant of ad interim anticipatory bail by this Court in the case of identically placed co-accused namely Resham Lal, Bhajan Kaur and Rajni Bala.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Saurav Khurana, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice

on behalf of the respondent and prays for time to argue the matter.

Adjourned to 08.11.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C, in the event of her arrest in FIR No.212 dated 29.09.2021, registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar, she shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-44550-2021.”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and that her custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 29.10.2021 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
