[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 02.03.2022 in CWP No.2270 of 2022 in case titled as Ram Singh and another vs. State of Punjab and another.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.2270 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider legal notice dated 26.10.2021 served by the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order with further directions that in case the petitioners were held entitled to the relief claimed and there was no impediment for granting the same, relief be granted to them without any delay.

[3] None is present on behalf of the petitioners. However, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has produced copy of order dated 31.05.2022 passed by the Managing Director, Pepsu Road

Transport Corporation, Patiala rejecting the claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 26.10.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof is stated to have been served on the petitioners.

[4] None is present on behalf of the petitioner. However, in view of the position noted above, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the matter and keeping the petition pending.

[5] Accordingly, the contempt petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 31.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
