The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.98 dated 22.04.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 307, 148 and 149 of the IPC (Section 307 IPC was deleted and Sections 325 and 326 IPC were added later on) at Police Station Model Town, Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sushil Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 12.09.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
