[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 21.05.2014 in CWP No. 17868 of 2013 in case titled as 'Sushma Devi and others vs. State of Haryana and others' (Annexure P-1) passed in terms of the directions dated 29.08.2013 in CWP No. 13001 of 2008 in case titled 'Narender Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others' (Annexure P-2).

[2] Affidavit has been filed by respondent No. 2 along with orders Annexure R-1 and R-2 in Court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

[3] Reply on behalf of respondent No.5 has already been filed. Copy of the aforementioned replies has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal of the same states that in view of order, Annexure R-2 dated 28.07.2016 i.e. speaking order passed by the Zonal Administrator, HUDA-cum-Additional Director, Urban Estate, Rohtak, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge speaking order

Annexure R-2 dated 28.07.2016 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, but without expressing any opinion on the maintainability of the instant petition, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
