Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the respondents are implementing the transfer policy in a manner, which has resulted in such a situation in some schools, the students are left with no teacher whereas, in some schools, a large number of posts have been filled up despite less number of students.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that there was no occasion to transfer the petitioners too far of places when, at the present place of posting, despite availability of students, the petitioners had been transferred and the posts held by the petitioners have been kept vacant for the reasons best known to the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that action of the respondents is contrary to the provisions of the transfer policy, which action is liable to be set aside.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as grievance being agitated before this Court has already been brought to the notice of the respondents by filing representation dated 29.08.2022 a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-18 and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this

stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the

same by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, representation dated 29.08.2022 (Annexure P-18), if not already decided then the same will be decided within a period of 10 days from today by passing an appropriate speaking order. In case, the petitioners have not been relieved so far from the present place of posting then they will be allowed to continue at the present place till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives at this stage and the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
