Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is non-release of the pensionary benefits despite being any impediment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the petition, the respondents have make certain payments but the calculation of the entitlement of the petitioner has not been done in a correct manner.

Learned counsel of the petitioner further submits that even the interest has not been paid on the delayed payment. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner intends to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation raising the said grievance and respondents may be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be dealt with in accordance with law and an appropriate order on the grievance of the petitioner as raised in the representation, will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of the same.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case after the decision of the representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary benefits, the same shall be released to him within a further period of two weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
