Petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR bearing No.41 dated 25.02.2022, under Sections 341/354-A IPC, 1860 and Sections 3 & 4 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that he has instructions to withdraw the present petition as petitioner No.2 has already instituted a petition bearing CRM-M-41626-2022 seeking the same relief at the earlier instance.

It may be mentioned here that there is a categoric plea in para 16 of the petition that no such or similar petition has been instituted in this Court. The tendency of the litigant to approach the Court by concealment of the material facts with regard to the pendency of the earlier petition is to be deprecated, and viewed seriously.

In view of the request, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, subject to the condition that the petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- within a period of 07 days in the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh on account of costs.
