Vide the instant second petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.263, dated 06.09.2020, registered for offences under Sections 302, 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Tauru, District Nuh, Annexure P-1.

Upon instructions received from SI Satish Kumar, State counsel submits that 20 out of 22 witnesses have been examined and the trial is at an advance stage.

Faced with this development, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition. He further submits that a direction can be issued to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a specific time frame.

Request of counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Considering the fact that the petitioner, who is a lady of 60 years of age and in custody since September, 2020, trial Court is requested to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible.
