 On request, the instant matter taken in Bi-Monthly Lok Adalat,
accordingly discussed.

 As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant
and learned counsel for respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz General Insurance
Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty
Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is
allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this
appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the
enhanced amount be paid to appellant-Surender.

 Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
appellant to provide his Bank details to respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz
General Insurance Company within one week from today. Pursuant thereto,
Insurance Company will deposit the agreed amount in the Bank Account of
appellant within three weeks thereafter. In case of failure to provide the Bank
details by the appellant, the Insurance Company shall deposit a crossed

Demand Draft in favour of the appellant drawn on any nationalized Bank with Lok Adalat of the High Court. In case of delay on the part of Insurance Company, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the Office of Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
