As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Companies, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.9,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further states that the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Smt. Bala Devi Wd/o late Sh. Bishmber Dayal, for & on behalf of all the appellants, in full & final settlement of their claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to both the Insurance Companies (Respondents 3 & 6) to deposit two cheques in the sum of Rs.4,50,000/- each favouring appellant No.1-Smt. Bala Devi Wd/o late Sh. Bishmber Dayal with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 15.06.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
