Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to consider the petitioner for re-employment as Consultant/Sr. Consultant against the post of Medical officer in view of letter dated 13.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) and letter dated 03.02.2022 (Annexure P-4).

2. A representation dated 23.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) was also submitted by petitioner, but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by the competent authority, either way, on the pending representations of the petitioner by passing a speaking order.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation, as suggested by learned State counsel.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the pending representation dated 23.06.2022 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, giving reasons thereof, in accordance with law. It is expected from the competent authority that before taking any appropriate decision it shall go through the letters (Annexures P-3 and P-4).

7. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible but in any case not later than 6 weeks.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
