The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 140, dated 03.05.2022, under Sections 147, 149, 302, 323, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 9-A, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR. He further submits that neither any beating nor any injury has been attributed to the present petitioner. He further submits that at the time of murder, 10-15 persons were present at the spot. Even in the disclosure statement of Vishal @ Vicky it is nowhere stated that the present petitioner was present at the spot.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in Court today, which is taken on record. He opposes the prayer made in the present petition on the ground that petitioner is involved in two more cases.

Keeping in view the antecedants of the petitioner and the facts that the petitioner is in custody for the last four months and the gravity of offences, this Court does not deem it a fit case for grant of regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
