The matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

CRM-M-41447-2020:

This petition has been filed seeking quashing, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2, of FIR No.0058, dated 20.02.2019 (as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom), registered at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 354-A, 406 and 498-A of the IPC. A copy of the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexure P-2 with the petition.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioners that

subsequently the respondent No.2 has died and a case bearing FIR No.90, dated 22.05.2021, under Section 304-B read with Section 34 of the IPC, has been registered against the petitioners at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

In view of the changed circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioners has sought to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

CRM-23601-2021:

As the main petition has been withdrawn, learned counsel for the applicant/respondent No.2 also seeks to withdraw the present application.

Application is also dismissed as withdrawn.
