This is a petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 90 dated 10.10.2019, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station P.S. Maloud, District Khanna, Ludhiana.

Bail is sought mainly on ground of custody period and that the trial is not progressing at decent pace.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that out of thirteen prosecution witnesses, four have been examined and as most of prosecution witnesses are police officials, earnest efforts would be made to examine the remaining witnesses within six months from the date fixed.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

There is no doubt that in case a request is made before the Court concerned for accommodating the date for examining the prosecution witnesses, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
