The petitioner seeks grant of pre-arrest bail in case bearing DDR No.25 dated 18.06.2022 registered under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 452, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sultwanwind, District Amritsar City in case bearing FIR No.78 dated 10.06.2022 under Sections 307, 326, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC, 1860 at Police Station Sultwanwind, District Amritsar City.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.09.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 06.12.2022 has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Maninder Singh, IPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar City and the same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.09.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
