Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that despite the fact that there is no valid impediment with the respondents but still the leave encashment has not been released to the petitioner though, he has already retired from service on 31.03.2020. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 02.08.2022 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Vivek Saini, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 02.08.2022 (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice, respondent No. 1 is directed to decide the representation dated 02.08.2022 (Annexure P-3), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
