The instant writ petition has been filed with a limited prayer for seeking promotion to the post of the Deputy Superintendent of Police along with all consequential benefits that would ensure thereafter.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued on 22.11.2018, reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 has been filed.

Learned State counsel would submit that the petitioner stands promoted on the post of the Deputy Superintendent of Police with effect from 04.01.2022 and, therefore, the petition has rendered infructuous.

On the basis of statement made above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant writ petition and seeks liberty to file afresh should any cause of action still survives.

Consequently, the instant writ petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage leaving it open to the petitioner to re-agitate, in any case grievance still survived.
