Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0113 dated 21.04.2021, under Sections 313, 34, 376(2)(n) of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station DLF Phase-3rd, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is behind the bars since 18.08.2021. He further submits that it was a consensual relationship. However, learned State counsel submits that in all, there are 16 prosecution witnesses, out of which, 13 witnesses stand examined and the next date for examining the remaining witnesses is 08.03.2022.

At this stage, this Court does not find it to be an appropriate stage for granting bail to the petitioner, however, as the material witnesses have already stand examined, learned trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the earliest.

In view of the above observation, petition stands disposed of.
