Allowed as prayed for subject to all just exceptions.

MAIN CASE

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside Clause 9 of the appointment letters dated 02.11.2018 (P-6), issued by respondent No.2, for the post of Medical Laboratory Technicians Grade-II (*for short 'MLT Grade-II'*).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioners submits that against the provisional select list dated 12.02.2021 (P-8),

petitioners have already filed their objections, but till date, no final decision has been taken in the matter by the competent authority.

In view of the above, learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the above objections are decided within some stipulated period.

Prayer seems to be justified to that extent.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioners, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the objections, filed by the petitioners against the provisional seniority list, by passing speaking order as per law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioners would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
